

## IT Guide for Preparation

## **Desktop icon**

For convenience, you will want to add a desktop shortcut to MultiCare Link.

In Windows
Right click on desktop > New > Shortcut
Type the location of the item:
https://link.multicare.org
Click Next.
Type a name for this shortcut:
MultiCare Link
Click Finish.

## **Trusted Sites**

To allow single sign-on authentication, you will want to add MultiCare to your Trusted Sites.

In Internet Explorer	
Click Tools > Internet Options	
Click the <b>Security</b> tab.	
Click the <b>Trusted sites</b> icon.	
Click the <b>Sites</b> button.	
Add this website to the zone:	
*.multicare.org	
Click Add.	
Click Close.	

## Citrix plug-in

The Citrix online plug-in will need to be installed on the local PC that will be running MultiCare Link.

In Windows	
Double-click the MultiCare Link desktop icon (previously created).	
Log into MultiCare Link using the provided credentials.	
Continue to provide your credentials when prompted.	
When prompted, click the green <b>Install</b> button to install the Citrix on-line plugin.	
You may see a yellow bar (security question) across the window. Choose <b>Allow</b> .
